Why literature reviews?

Remember: “Mapping the social economy of dried fish in South and Southeast Asia for enhanced wellbeing and nutrition”

Literature reviews give us:

- first sense of shape of what is known
- starting point for our research

1. The place of literature reviews in DFM

Literature reviews as evolving process, not one final product:

1. The literature is changing
2. Different functional roles in project:
 1. Global
 2. DFM research team
 3. Thematic and student projects
3. These will build on each other and deepen Zotero database

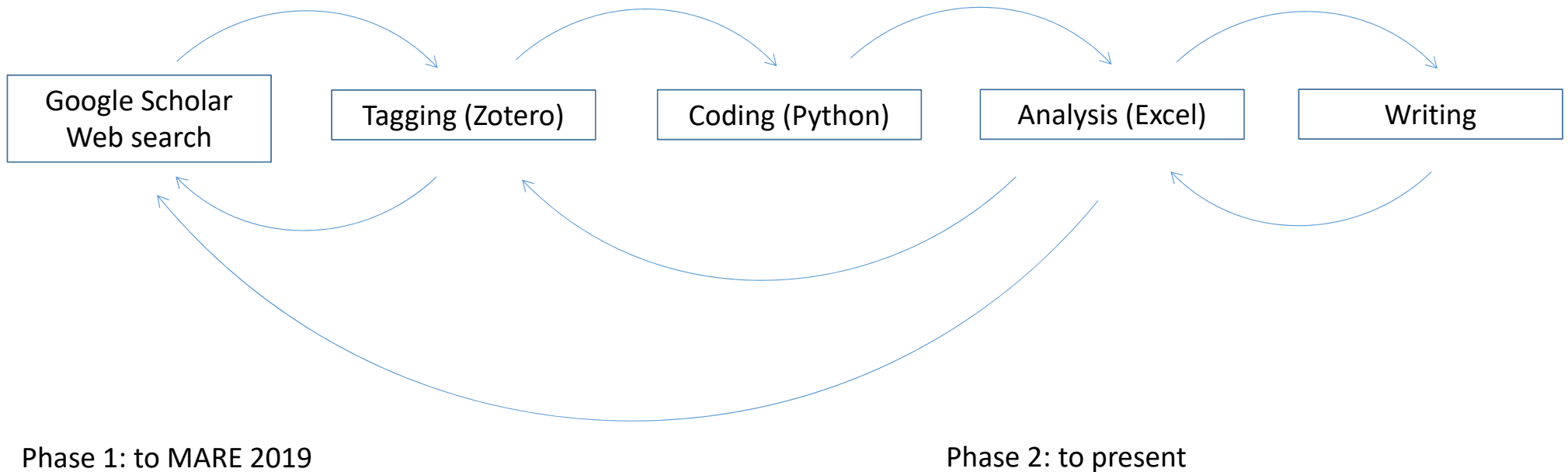

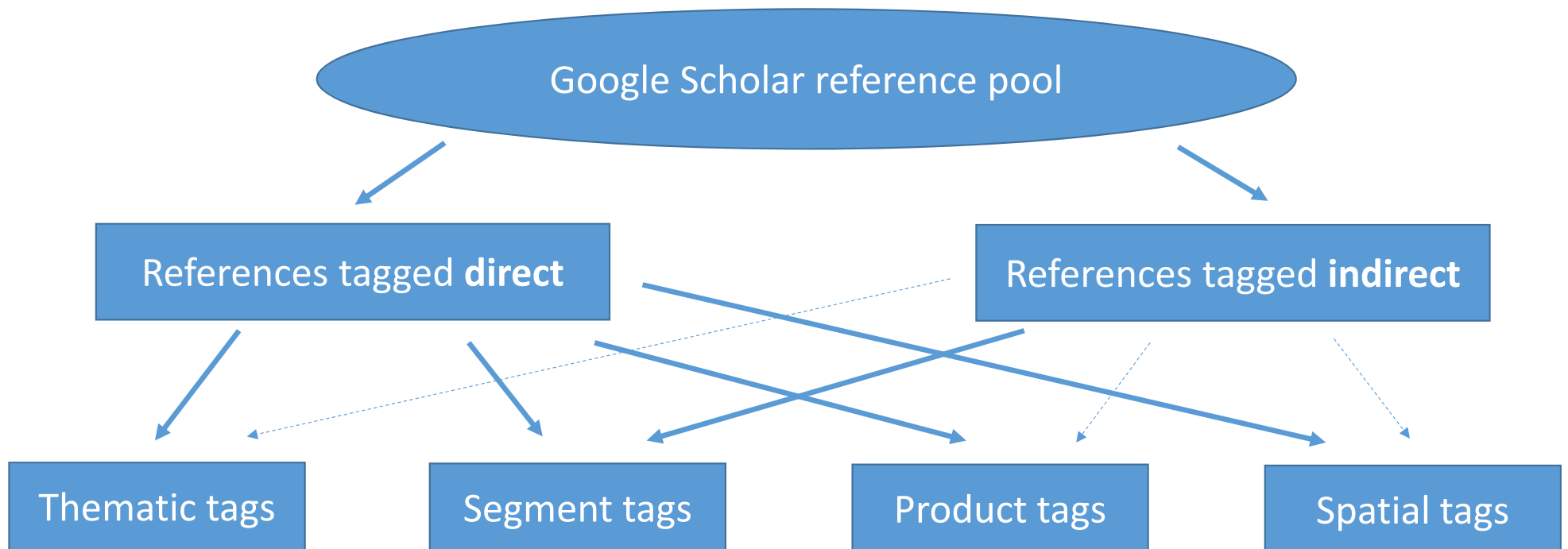
Thematic focus: DFM thematic interests vs. actual thematic variation in existing literature

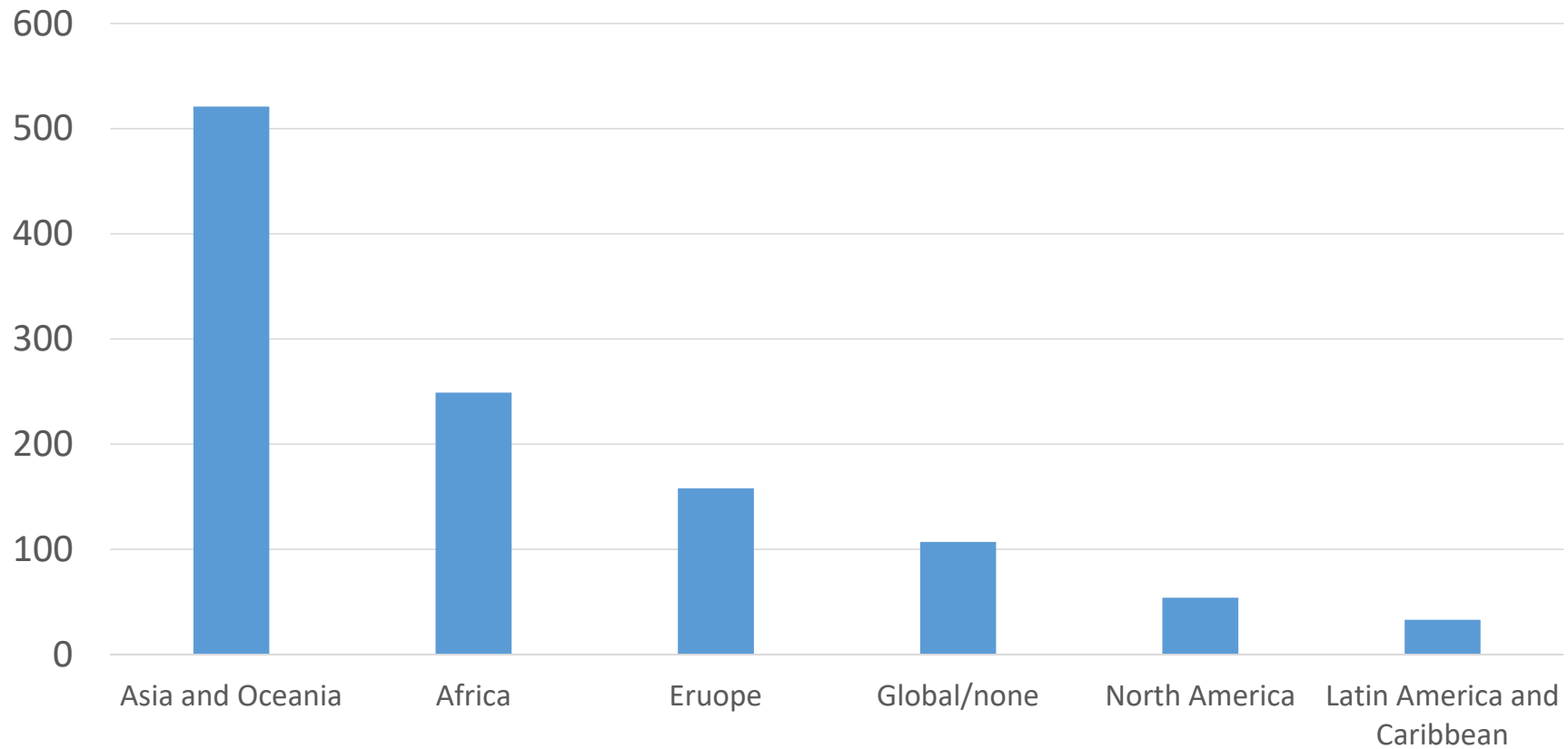

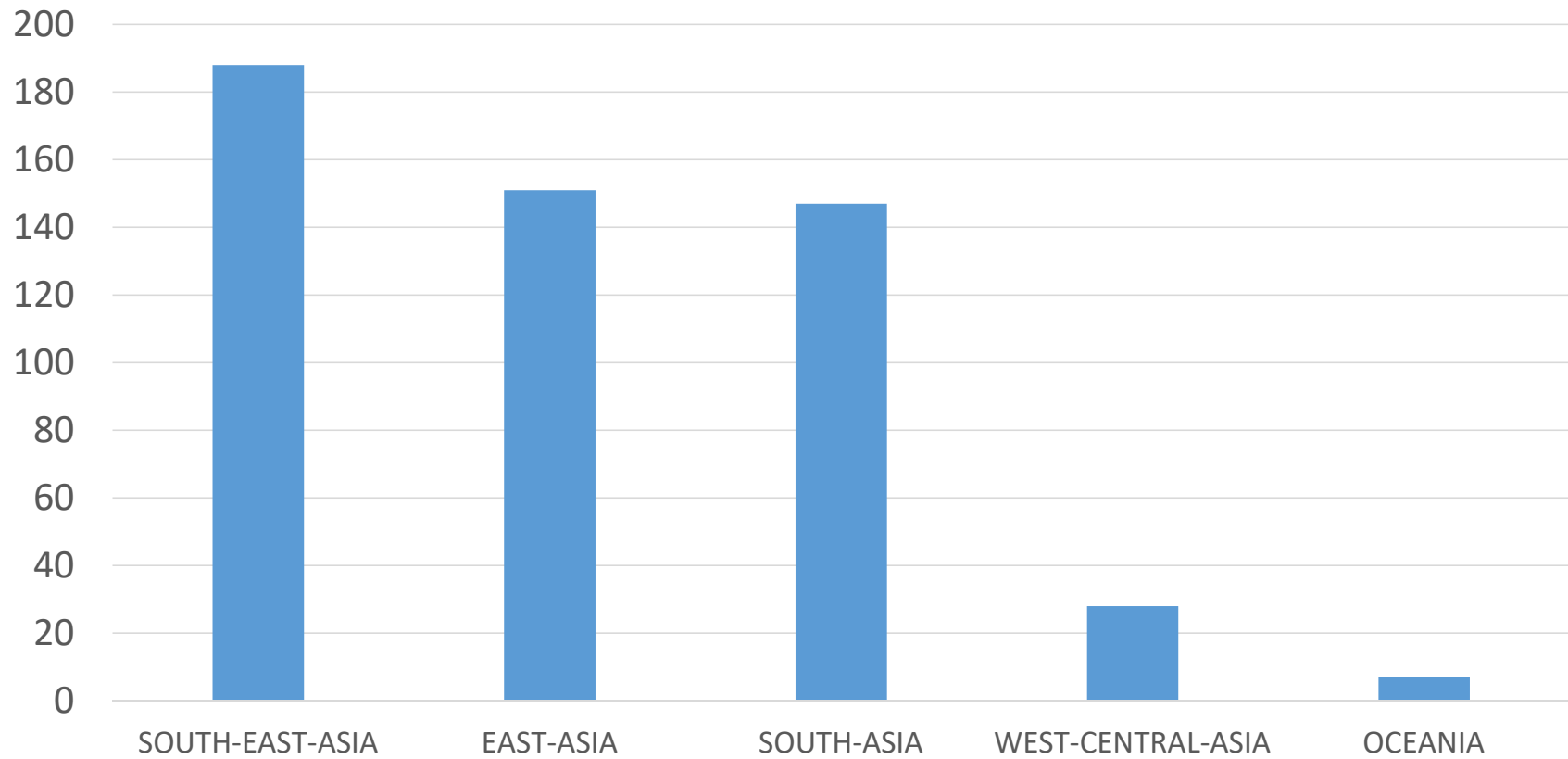
These are first stage quantitative results of the *shape* of the literature

Detailed qualitative analysis is ongoing

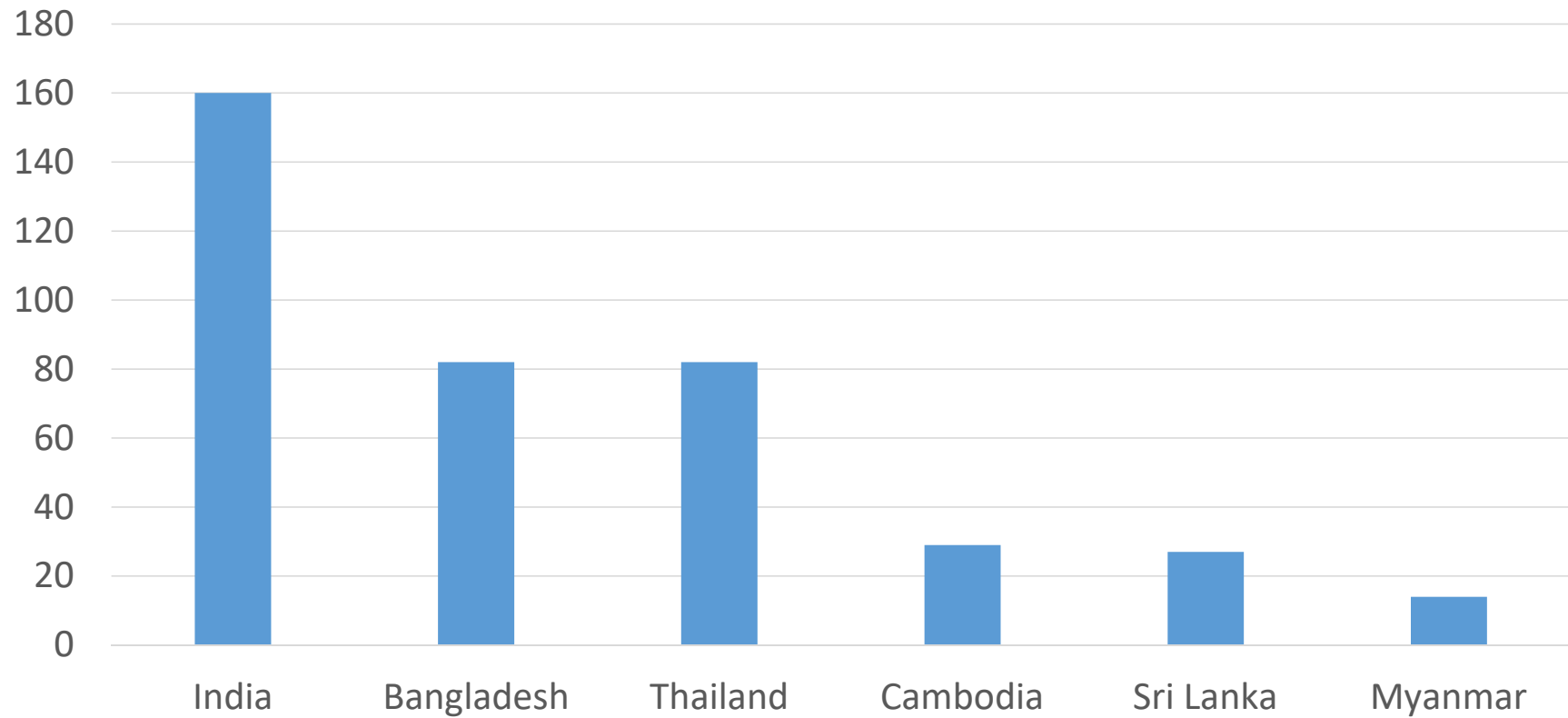
Dried fish references by continent



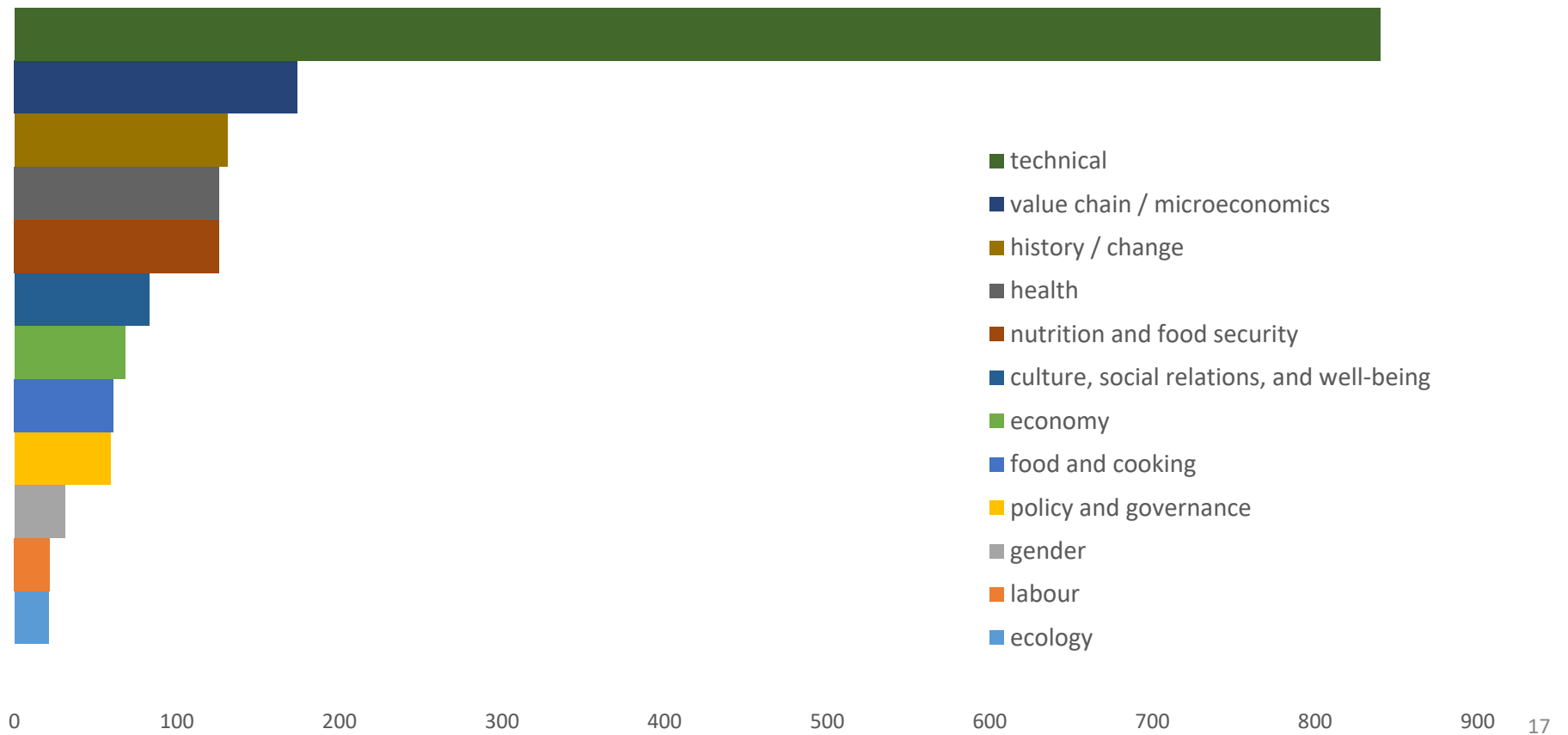
Asian dried fish references



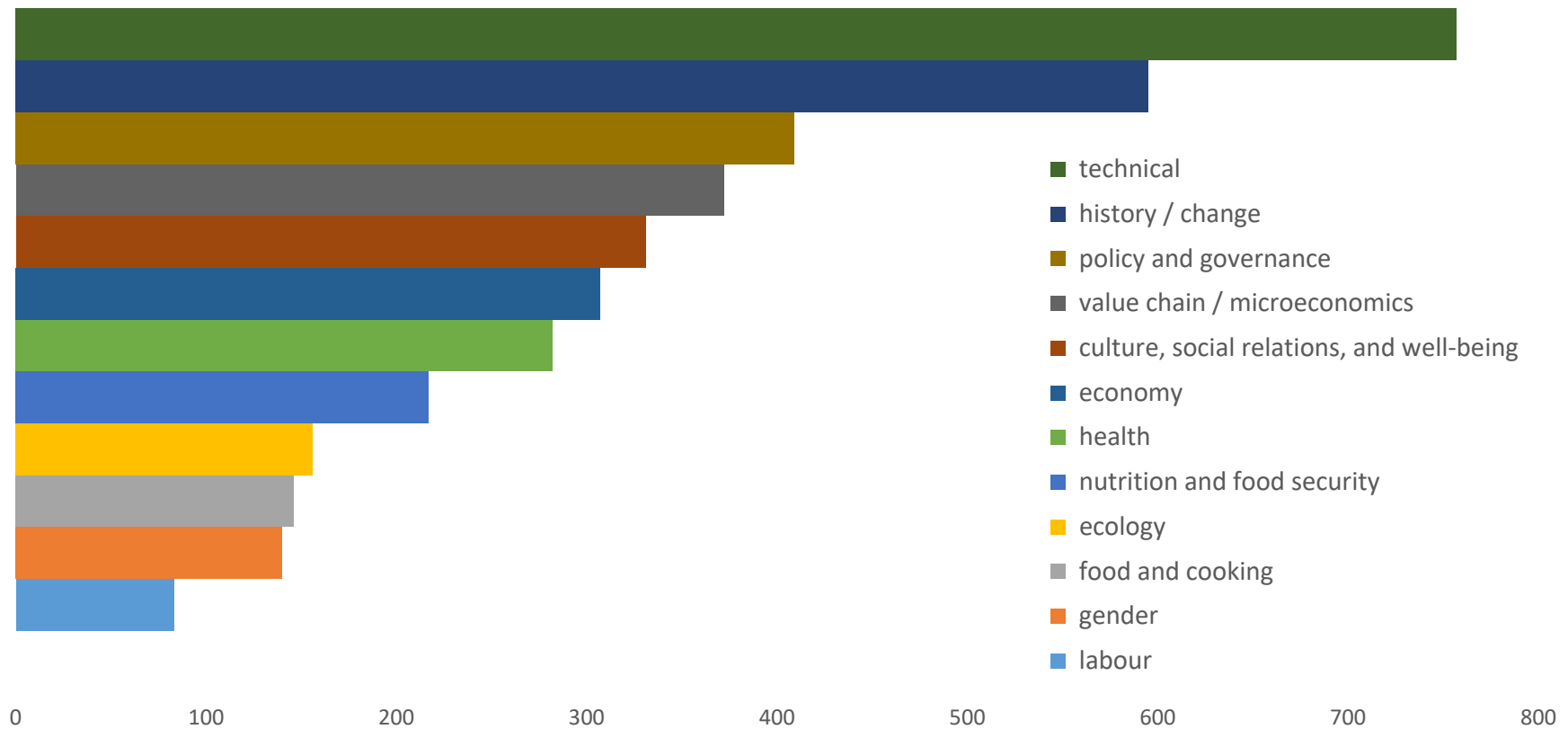
DFM focus country dried fish references



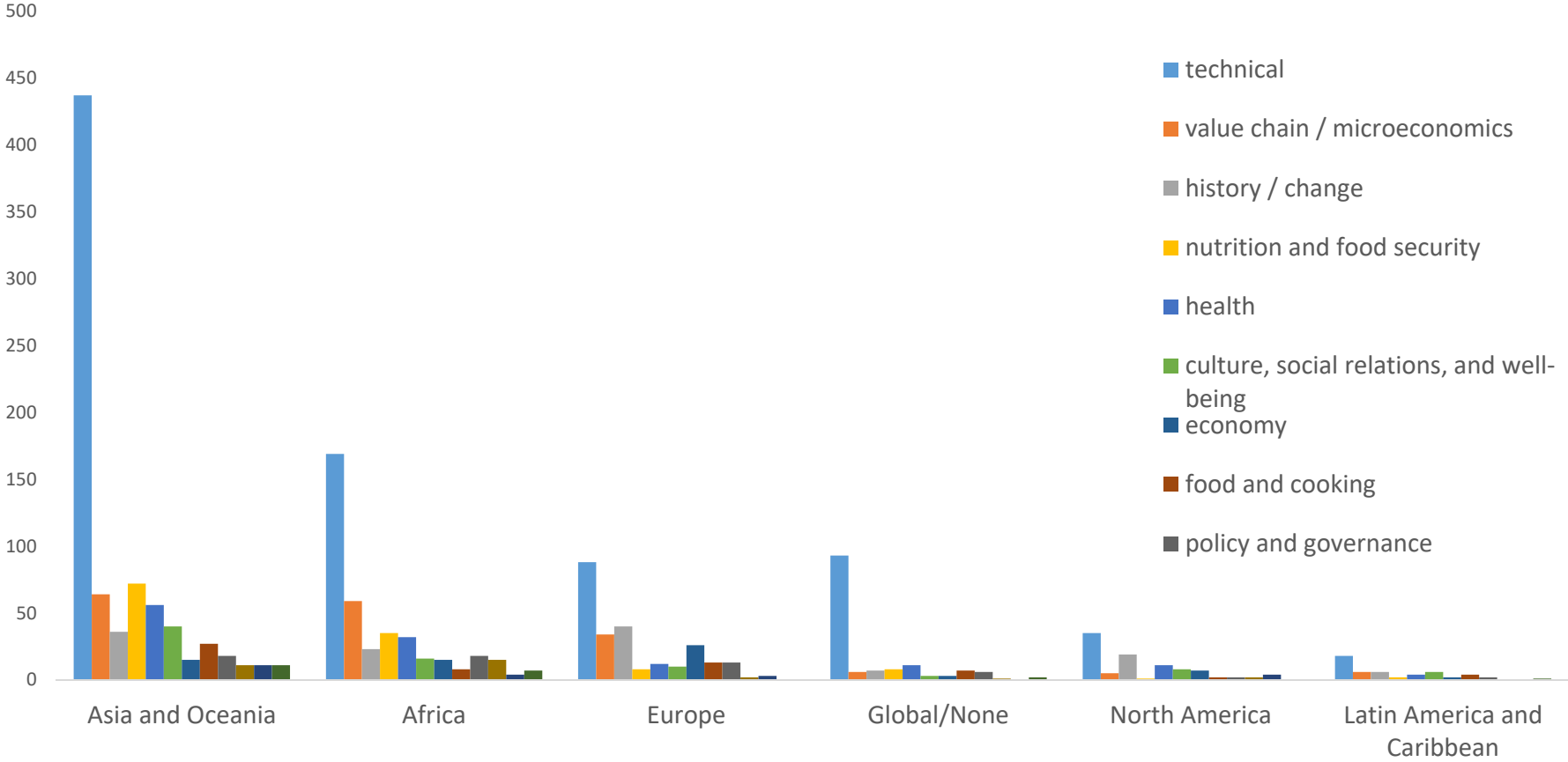
Themes in direct dried fish literature



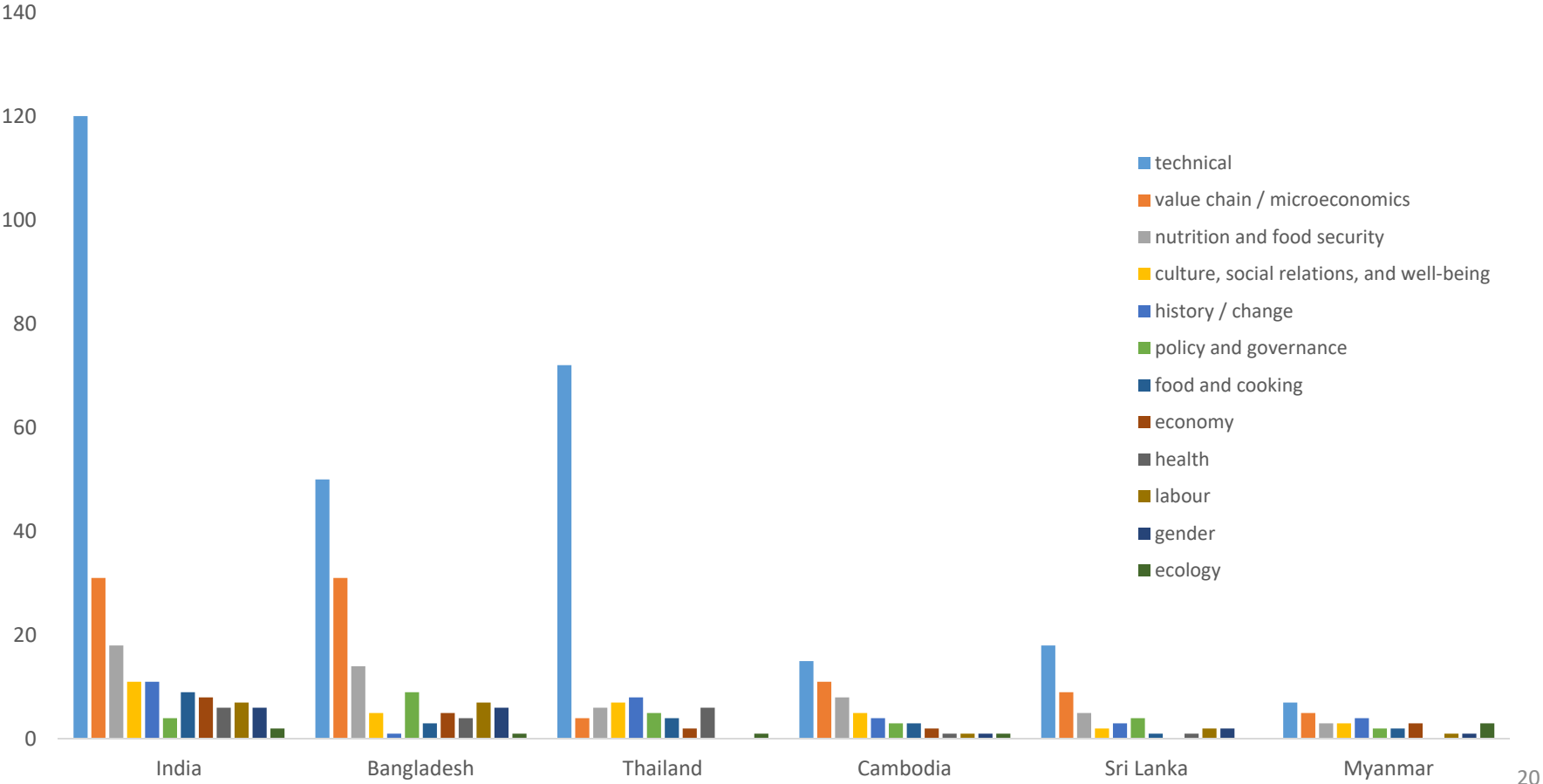
Themes in indirect dried fish literature



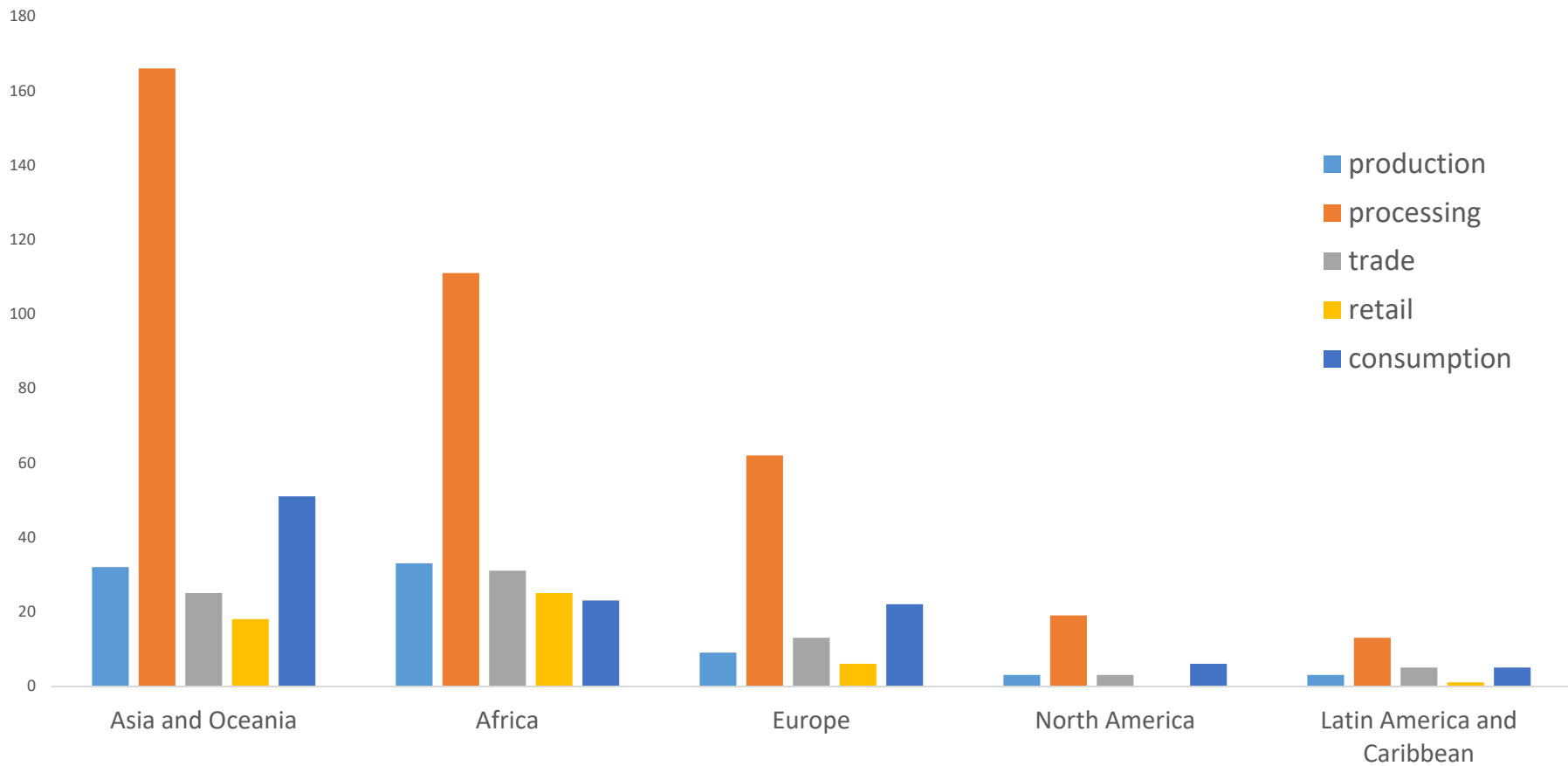
Themes by continent



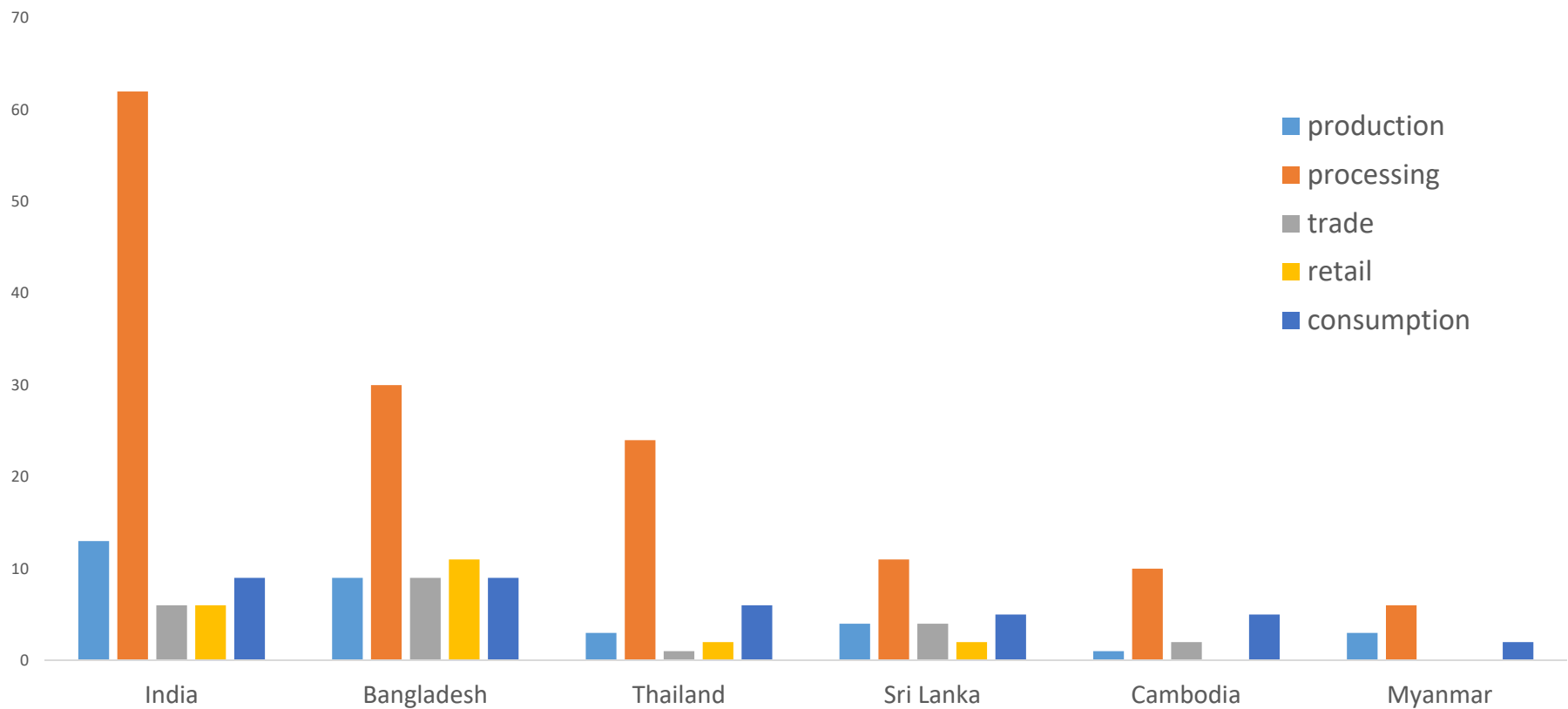
Themes by DFM focus country



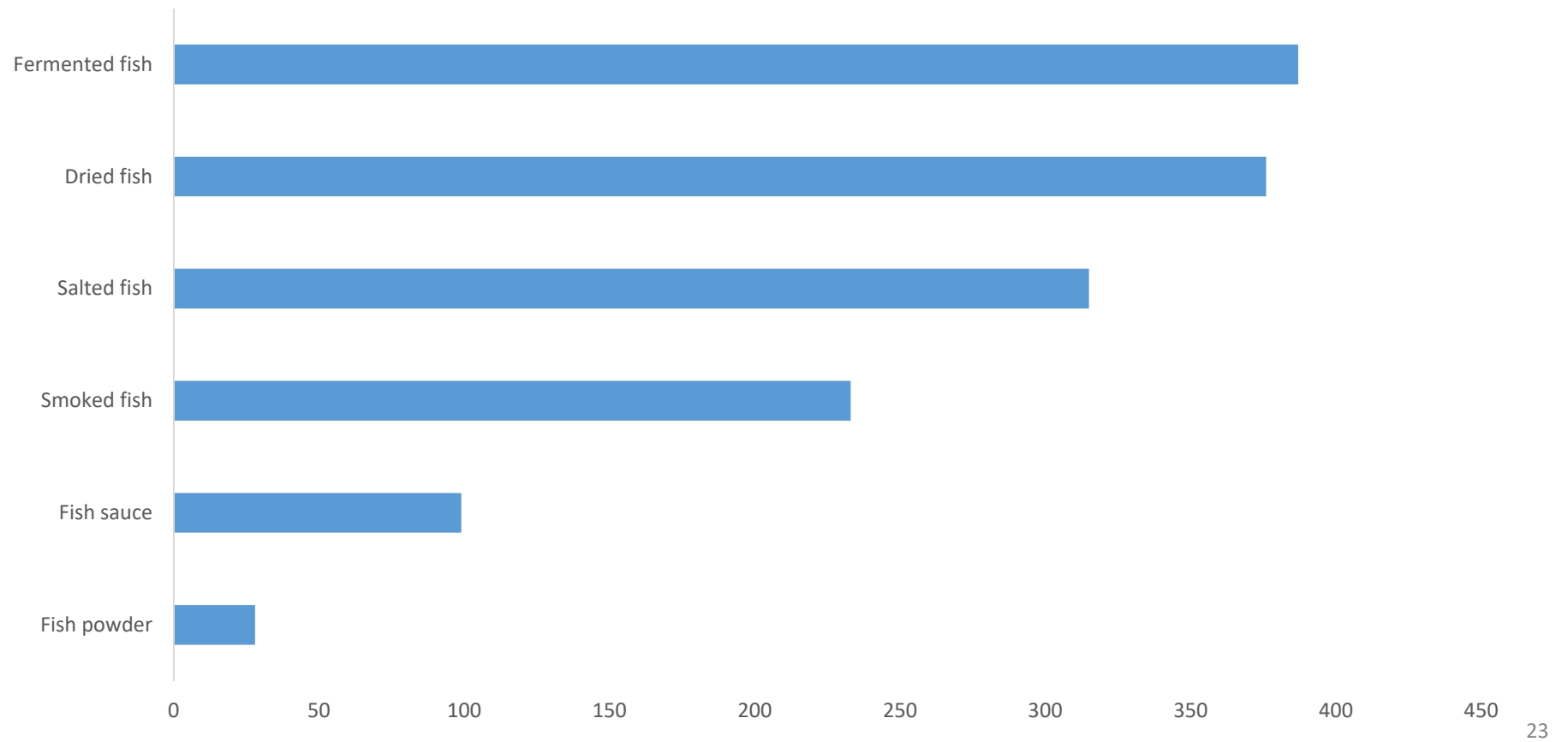
Value chain segment by continent



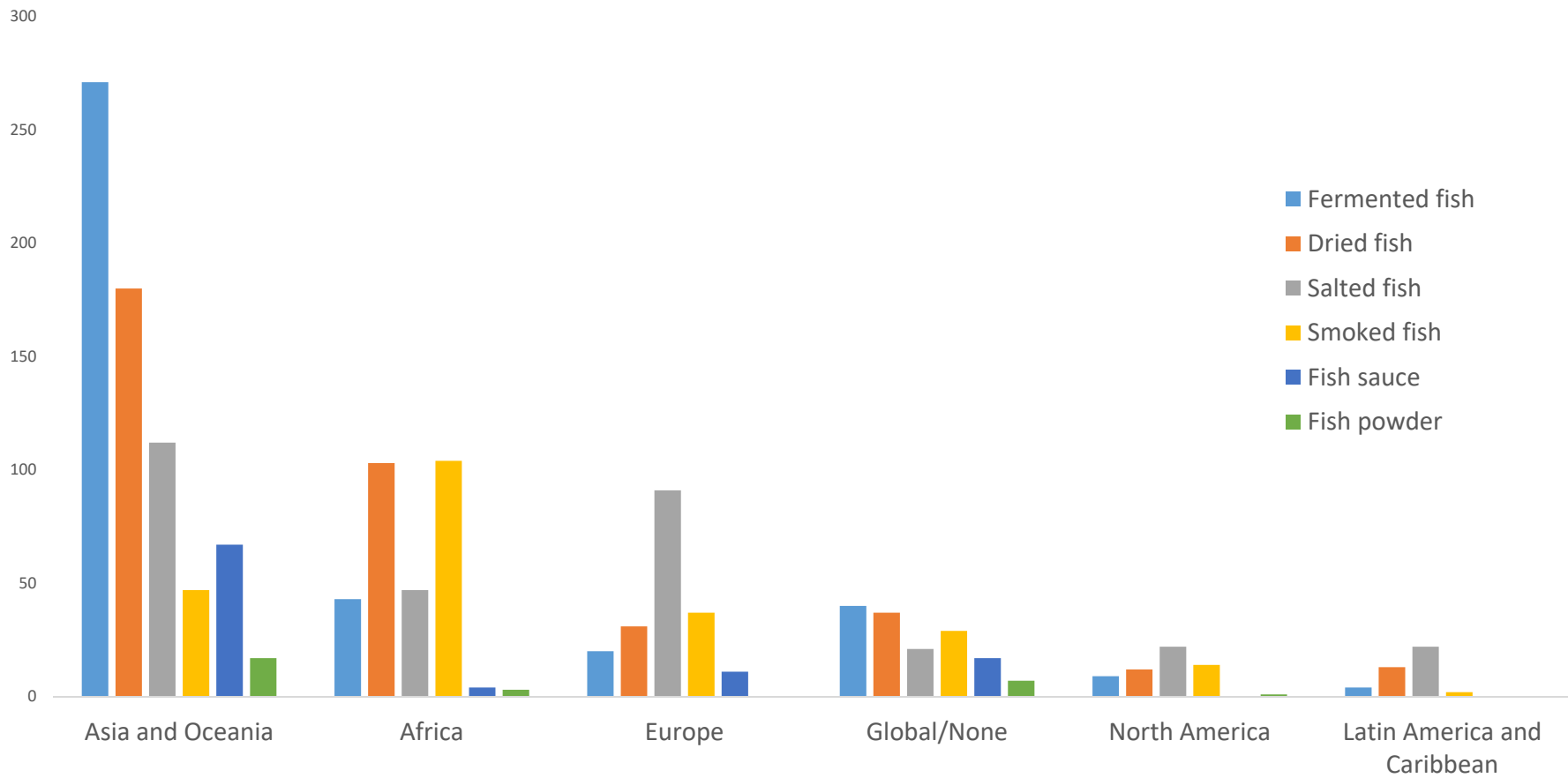
Value chain segment by DFM focus country



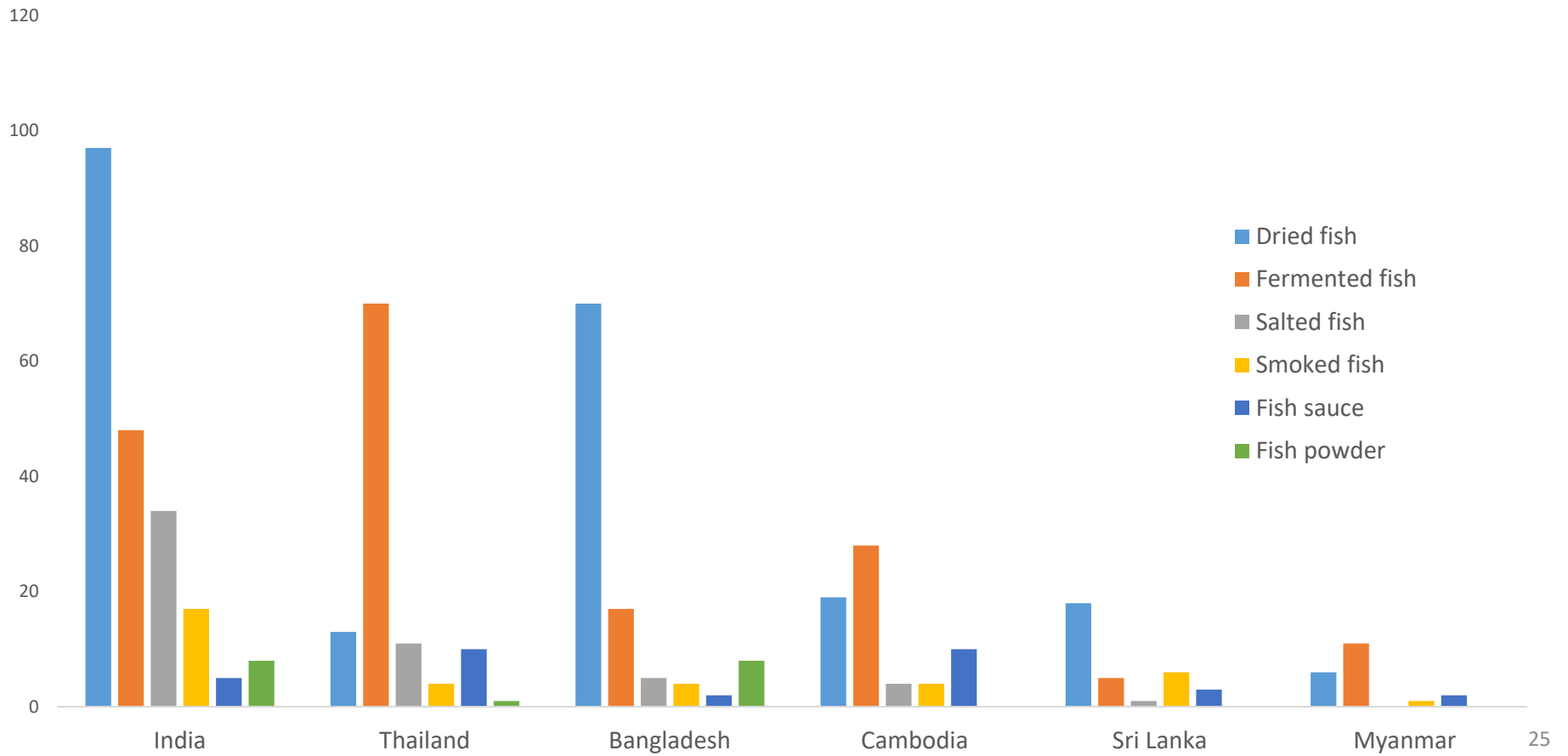
Product type by continent
